

Prices for IASC 2025

All prices include lodging (in the hostel, it's cabins or in your own tent/caravan/mobile home on the grounds of the hostel), full access to all regular facilities of the hostel, 3 meals a day (breakfast buffet, lunch, dinner) including warm or cold beverages appropriate to the meal, and access to all activities taking place at IASC 2025. The prices for rooms in the hostel and it's cabins include getting linen (sheets, pillowcases, duvet covers).

We point out that there may be some activities on-site that raise extra fees (i.e. bus excursions, workshops that require certain materials, external food trucks etc.) but most of the activities will be free.

Solidarity prices:

We are offering free tickets for children up to 3 and reduced prices for children up to 15. We have to pay for them, though. To make this possible, there are solidarity tickets that can be purchased voluntarily. Nobody is obliged to buy these and there are no privileges if you decide to do so, but we do encourage everyone who is capable to do so.

We will also have a fundraising at IASC 2025 to support free admission for children and some projects that will be introduced at IASC before the auction. If there is a surplus after IASC 2025, the money will go to AEN as a starter for next IASC.

Terms and conditions, cancellation and refund policy (ToC)

Terms and conditions

- 1) **IASC** (International Asatru Summercamp) is a non-profit, non-commercial event that is carried and hosted by the Asatru Europe Network e.V. (**AEN**).
- 2) AEN is a non-profit, non-commercial private association of heathen organisations, groups and individuals from European countries. The registration includes no warranties and no liabilities on behalf of AEN.
- 3) The Code of Conduct is binding for all registrants.
- 4) Registrations are only valid when confirmed by email and having paid the down payment. They are treated as applications as long as the final payment has not been made.
Down payments will be **40%** of the total amount of the registration after it is confirmed by the staff. If a registration is altered after the down payment has been made, the amount of the down payment is not affected.
- 5) Down payments are due within 3 weeks after notification by the booking committee. Final payments are due June **27th, 2025**, except for late registrations after that date. For late registrations, the full amount is due immediately after notification.
Payments via Paypal will have a surcharge of 2% to cover payment costs.
- 6) Since there are limited capacities, not all applications for 2-bed-rooms or other desired lodging facilities may be fulfilled. The booking committee will contact you if your application cannot be met. If negotiations fail and you cancel your reservation due to that, there will be a full refund of the complete amount paid so far, regardless of the date.
- 7) If a shortage of desired lodging facilities occurs, the booking committee will assign the facilities according to the following order:
 - duration of stay – registrations for the full week will be favoured
 - age/health conditions – elderly and handicapped persons will be favoured
 - date of registration – first come, first serve

Cancellations

- 8) Cancellation of registrations is possible at any time without giving a reason. Cancellation can be done either
 - here in the booking frontend - edit your registration and select cancellation
 - or by mail to booking@asatru-summercamp.org referring to the registration ID.

Refunds

- 9) Refunding of already paid amounts:
 - up to May 27th, 2025 all so far paid down payments or fees will be fully refunded except for a handling fee of 10,00 € per reservation (not per person) when cancelled.
 - up to June 27th, 2025 all so far paid down payments or fees will be refunded 50% of the total registration fee.
 - after July 16th, 2025, there will be no more refunds.
- 10) If registrants cannot take advantage of the reservation they made and have paid for after the camp has started on July 26th, 2025, there will be no refund of any sort. It does not matter if the reasons for that are based on their individual status or if they have been expelled from the camp by decision of the IASC Council.

The IASC Code of Conduct (CoC) – IASC

The International Asatru Summercamp (IASC) has the aim of bringing together Asatruar for the furthering of understanding between Asatruar, the knowledge of the different aspects and practices of Asatru and hence expanding our horizon on Asatru today.

As a participant at the IASC you commit yourself to comply with the IASC Code of Conduct.

- 1.) **We show respectful behavior to each other:** The Mission Statement of AEN <https://www.asatru-europe.network/mission-statement/> is the primary guideline for everyone's experience and conduct at the Camp. Treat all participants with respect, dignity, and courtesy. We reject any form of racism, discrimination and abuse based on ethnicity, nationality, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age, or other personal characteristics. We support and welcome LGBTQ+ visibility.
- 2.) **We all take care of children and their safety:** Still parents/guardians must supervise their children all times. Only parents/guardians may photograph/take videos of their own children. Children's areas are alcohol-free and non-smoking zones.
- 3.) **Participation in rituals and ceremonies:** Participation in any ritual, ceremony or spiritual practice is always voluntary. As well as when drinking horns are passed in rituals, there is no pressure to partake. Register planned rituals with the IASC Council.
- 4.) **IASC Council Role:** The Council serves as a mediating body between different groups and individuals. All problems and violations within the Code of Conduct will be taken care of by the IASC Council, which will make decisions regarding camp operations. Report any concerns to Council members in person, or by email (council@asatru-summercamp.org), or via the feedback box.
- 5.) **Consequences for Violations of CoC:** Violations of Code of Conduct and frithgarth of IASC may result in warnings, temporary exclusion from activities, requirement to leave the Summer Camp without refund, or even ban from future events (depending on the form of violation). The IASC Council will determine appropriate consequences in each individual case. The Council's decisions cannot be contested.
- 6.) **Community Responsibility:** Creating a positive, safe, and inclusive community environment at IASC is our goal and shared responsibility. We acknowledge the diverse backgrounds, traditions, and perspectives within Asatru. And we strive to create accessible environments for children, elderly and individuals with disabilities.
- 7.) **Environmental Responsibility – take care for Mother Nature:** Respect the campsite premises and its surrounding natural areas. Properly dispose waste, recycle, and participate in community work to maintain and clean the campsite when requested, and according to the rules of the premise.
- 8.) **Each of us responsible for our deeds:** The organizers of IASC aren't responsible for the acts and/or deeds of individual participants at IASC. IASC and its organizers carry no collective responsibility. They are also not responsible for damage arising during IASC and inflicted on persons or personal property.
- 9.) **Photography and Privacy Policy:** General photography/video is permitted on the campgrounds. But before making photos or videos during rituals or workshops, please take individuals consent about it. If the person has "No Photo/Video" badge, please respect this.
- 10.) **Alcohol Consumption and smoking:** Drink alcohol wisely and in healthy amounts. Never force others to drink. Strictly forbidden providing alcohol to minors and drink alcohol in children's and alcohol-free zones. Smoking is only allowed in the so assigned areas, but never indoors.
- 11.) **Dogs and other pets rules:** If the campsite allows dogs and other pets, the camp site rules about pets have to be followed. Pets are always at the full responsibility of their owners.

The IASC Code of Conduct (CoC) – IASC

The IASC Council

The Council consists of experienced persons from different countries who are selected by the Board of Asatru Europe Network. The list of Council members will be displayed at the Camp.

The Council will take care of all disputes that may arise within the terms defined in the Code of Conduct.

The Council will also take care of other disputes that may arise amongst participants if these disputes in any way could hamper the camp. If a dispute arises the Council will assemble immediately after notification.

Things brought before the council will be taken care of by the following procedure:

- 1.) The people involved in the matter are entitled to tell their version of the matter to the Council. They speak one at the time and may not be interrupted.
- 2.) The members of the council may then ask questions to the case.
- 3.) The Council will then retire and find a solution to the matter.
- 4.) The solution will be announced through a spokesperson determined by the council.
- 5.) The decisions of the IASC Council are final.

Failure to comply with the decisions of the Council will result in immediate expulsion from the IASC.
